

# COOKEVILLE WATER FACT SHEET

The Cookeville Water and Sewer Department has about 13,500 metered customers on its water system. Our community is fortunate to have an abundant supply of water from Center Hill Lake. The system has a pumping capacity of 15 million gallons per day. The current consumption level is around 11 million gallons per day.

Water is treated by a several step process including: flash mix, flocculation, clarification, filtration, and chlorination. This modern water treatment plant also has a capacity of cleaning 15 million gallons per day. Five water tanks allow the city to store over 19.5 million gallons of water to meet system demand and free flow requirements.

First 2,000 gallons per month	\$6.50 Minimum Bill
All gallons over 2,000 per month	\$2.55 per 1,000 gallons

  

<i>Rates for users of water outside the corporate limits of the City of Cookeville</i>	
First 2,000 gallons per month	\$9.75 Minimum Bill
All gallons over 2,000 per month	\$3.80 per 1,000 gallons

Water storage rates for all users other than contracted wholesale users = \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons.
